PASTORS CONFERENCE, OPEN-AIR CRUSADE & MINISTRY TO THE POOR

We will be traveling to Kakinada, India for ten ministry filled days of outreach. Our goal is to use God's healing miracles to open the hearts of Hindu nationals, His anointing to encourage and exhort native pastors, and His heart to minister to the needs of the very poor, orphans and widows. We are asking you to come along side us with your blessing, prayer and support to make this outreach a success in every way.

Pastor Anil is our connection to Kakinada India. We have been in contact over the past several months and have built a relationship of trust and cooperation. We have participated with Anil in distributing 160 bibles to members of his church. Prior to the distribution, only 90 believers in his 2 churches of over 300 people had bibles. We have also provided funds for the distribution of blankets for the widows.

Kakinada, India

Kakinada, a city of 300,000 people, was a rural town that has grown recently into a recognized Metropolitan area. It is on the eastern coast of India, overlooking the Indian Ocean. It is a very poor region with average wages of \$1-1.50 per day.



Islam is the dominate religion with indigenous people being 80% Hindu, 10% Muslim and 3% Christian. Although there are many orphans and elderly widows, there are minimal orphanages or facilities to care for the poor in Kakinada.

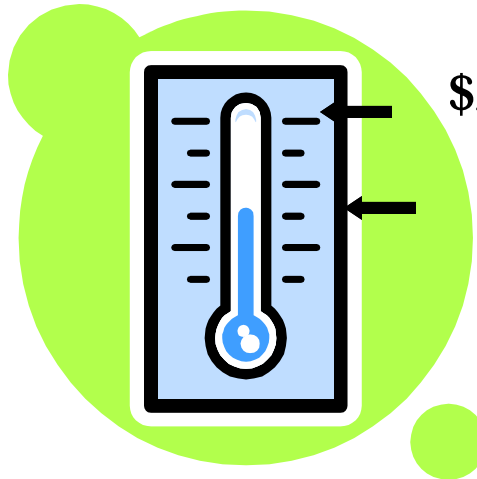
